V. PADMANAND is a renowned industry and SME development specialist whose areas of expertise include cluster value chain, entrepreneurship, management, and business environment development. Author of 6 books, research papers and articles, Padmanand has M.Phil. degrees from the University of Cambridge, U.K., and Madras University, India, and advanced management education. VINANCHIARACHI JEBAMALAI is an eminent economist with a practical foresight, currently serving as the Principal Advisor to the Director General, United Nations Industrial Development Organisation (UNIDO), Vienna. The author had secured several awards for outstanding academic performance, including gold medal from St. Joseph's College, Trichy. His doctoral thesis on the East Asian model of development partly predicted the East Asian financial crisis in terms of vulnerabilities stemming from high import intensity of export orientation. He has several books and publications to his credit. His most recent book is titled *Rethinking Development Realities*, which has been selected as the best book in Economics by an Indian author in 2007. He was also conferred the UNIDO Director General's award for outstanding performance.
