As per the Government Order read as second paper, Government ordered to cease the grant-in-aid ordered as per the Government Order read first. In the Government Order read as first paper Government ordered an yearly grant-in-aid at the rate of Rs.9,000/- to State Unit and Rs.6,000/- to district units of KSSIA.

The KSSIA in their representation read as third paper requested to withdraw the Government Order read as second paper above and to enhance the yearly grant-in-aid in view of the circumstances stated by them therein.

Government after examining the matter in detail are pleased to order that the Government Order read as second paper above stands withdrawn and that the benefits at the rates ordered in the Government Order first are restored.

O R D E R

In the G.O. read as first paper above, Government have issued the rules for regulating the issue of grant to the State/District Small Industrial Association in the State. These rules were amended by the G.O. read as second paper above.

Now the Director of Industries & Commerce has proposed certain amendments to the existing rules for grant-in-aid. Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to issue the following amendments to the rules issued as per G.O.s read above:-

1. Rules 2(a):-

Cost of Technical books purchased every year to set up information library may be subsidised to the extent of 50% of the cost subject to a maximum of Rs. 3000/- (Rupees three thousand only) per District State Association.

2. Rule 2(c):-

Grant to the extent of 50% of the expenditure involved against subscription to journals and other publications for interest to the Industry subject to a maximum of Rs. 600/- (Rupees Six hundred only) a year.

3. Rules 2(e):-

Reimbursement of an annual grant to the extent of 100% subject to a maximum of Rs. 9000/- (Rupees Nine Thousand only) and Rs. 6000/- (Rupees Six thousand only) for the State and District Association respectively for the dissemination of relevant information to the units against (i) Stationary (ii) preparation of brochures, Pamphlets, Printing charges and (iii) postage and telephone charges only.

4. Rule 2(g):-

A grant to the extent of 100% of the expenditure involved in the conduct of Seminars/exhibition of the products of SSI sector will be reimbursed upto a ceiling of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) per exhibition/Seminar limiting to Rs. 6000/- (Rupees Six thousand only) a year.

The rules issued as per Govt. Orders read above, will stand modified to the above extent.
